- **Flexible** – Fits through standard doorways and elevators and is flexible enough to maneuver in most spaces. Includes forklift channels for easy lifting.

Shot blasting with Blastrac® is the quickest, most effective way to remove contaminants from a concrete floor. This includes old adhesives, paint, grease, oil – anything that could prevent a clean bond with your new flooring system. Operated by our trained technicians, the Blastrac cleans and profiles in one easy step. Because the unit vacuums and contains all debris, Blastrac is environmentally friendly, too. Shot blasting does not introduce chemical adhesive solvents, which have high vapor emissions and can attack new adhesives.
